MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School diploma or high school equivalent diploma.
- Welding Certifications preferred.
- Must have a minimum of (3) years successful employment as a welder.
- Must be proficient in the use of general SMAW, GMAW, GTAW machines.
- Must be proficient in measurement, layout, and blueprint reading.
